# **ABC Link Prayers**

Rebel activity continues in eastern DRC. A Mission Partner writes of 'the slow. grinding conflict in Eastern Congo which daily claims victims who never reach the headlines'. Someone has estimated that there have been 122 rebel groups over 25 years. The Norwegian Refugee Council says this is the world's most neglected refugee crisis: there are 5 million displaced people and 1 million refugees (in other countries). Boga and the southern part of Aru Diocese are particularly affected.

In spite of this background, the work of the gospel goes on. At the beginning of June one deacon and 12 priests were ordained in Aru. The ministry among young girls who have been victims of sexual abuse continues in Boga Diocese. Aru Diocese is grateful for the Chester grant, which enabled them to provide roofing sheets for a school and help with the school fees for certain children. Mission Partner, Peter Wyard, carries on the task of introducing the discipleship course Rooted in Jesus.

Archbishop Ande will be attending the Lambeth Conference. We've not yet heard from Bishop William.

#### PRAYER POINTS

- For peace and an end to the killing in Eastern DRC
- For participants in Rooted in Jesus to learn how to interact rather than be talked at
- That the new deacons and priests may be used greatly by God to spread the gospel in word and deed
- For Ven Jean Bagada's project with abused girls, that funding will increase so more girls can be helped
- Safe travel, wisdom, patience and love for the bishops as they attend Lambeth

# **Pastoral Worker Training**

Pastoral Workers are a skilled and flexible resource for the Church. They are licensed by the bishop and are called to draw alongside people in their parish who need pastoral support. This is a ministry of presence and attentiveness which is worked out in a wide variety of ways. Some Pastoral Workers also exercise their ministry in places beyond their parish, acting as a bridge between the church and the world as they share the love of God with those in their communities and places of work and volunteering.

There are currently 17 men and women training to be Pastoral Workers in the Diocese of Chester, and together as a learning community they are committed to deepening in discipleship and growing in skill and ability. Done well, training and formation for licensed ministry is both a demanding and joyous time – students often reflect on how much they learn about themselves, others, and God, and how much they grow in faith.

Those training for Pastoral Worker ministry sometimes express surprise that God has called them to this ministry of walking alongside others. They speak of the sense of privilege and responsibility they feel to serve in this way, and those who minister alongside them testify to the rich significance of their quiet but profound work.

# Prayer points:

- Give thanks for those who serve as Pastoral Workers in the diocese
- For those studying, that they will know God's presence with them as they deepen in faith and learning
- For those preparing for those to be licensed in October, that they will feel confident in the path God has set before them
- For people to hear God's call to this ministry, and to be encouraged and nurtured as they
  respond to that call
- For parishes without Pastoral Workers, that God might stir a vocation to this ministry in people's hearts
